## Information We Collect

Any email messages and associated information that you send to addresses published on this website are not governed by this policy.

## Use & Disclosure of Information

To the extent that we collect personally identifiable information for event/webinar registration, we use the information solely in connection with organization of the event for which you registered. We use it, for example, to track registration, confirm attendance, and furnish biographical details to relevant staff.

If you request at the time of your registration, or at any time afterward, we may use this information to call to your attention similar events/webinars that might be of interest to you.

We share user information gathered from our cookie or pixel on this website with third parties for direct marketing purposes. We may, share your contact information with our ministry partners. Your registration information for a particular event may be provided to any event partners or co-sponsors for that event, each of whom will be identified to you at the time of registration. The privacy policies of these partners and co-sponsors may differ from this one.

We may disclose your personally identifiable information if we reasonably believe we are required by law to do so.
